Using contemporary printed sources, she compares Poitiers to other cities and draws general conclusions about royal policies toward provincial cities. *Between Crown and Community* illustrates in precise and sometimes dramatic fashion the actual performance of politicalthe interaction of political identities, rhetorical strategies, and ritual practices with the civic traditions of the premodern urban world.
